* Dave is asking members if they would like to receive Klingspor Woodworking Shop Catalogue to let him know and he will give them your name and address.

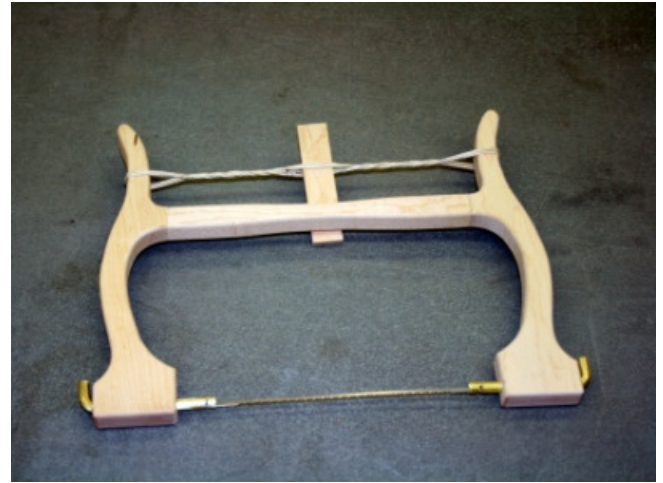
