Back in April, I mentioned that I had removed a tree and needed a replacement. I was looking to replace it with a native Iowa tree, a hackberry, but was encouraged by my wife to get a tree with nice fall colors. We ended up with a hybrid maple, Autumn Blaze. I am not fond of the maple hybrids, in general because some have poor structure/ shape and shorter life spans, but in the end, aesthetics won out. Maybe next time I will get a native tree.

At the May meeting, several videos were presented in lieu of a speaker. Two were on aspects of table saw safety, where we learned the mechanics (in slow motion) of the phenomenon of kickback and how dangerous it can be. Another video was of an amazing table that incorporated the use a spirograph jig in the making of a design on a tabletop. If you didn't make it to the meeting, or want to see the videos again, an email with links to the video will be sent out to members.

Also in May, there was a tour of Kreg Tool in Huxley, Iowa. The Huxley plant does machining of metal parts and injection molding of various components used in their products. We learned of the processes required to achieve the quality needed in the parts and the push to bring parts 'in house' that had been made 'off shore'. We had 16 people attend the tour.

For our June meeting, member Kevin Gade will tell us how he makes banding inlays and a give a demonstration of some of the process.


