Greetings woodworkers!

This past month we have been busy putting together upcoming events for the CVWA. It's always a challenge to keep the monthly speaker pipeline filled. The May meeting will not have a dedicated speaker, but will have videos selected by your board members to help educate, and hopefully be of interest to our members. One video will be on table saw safety, and another will be a project of interest.

Our April 8th meeting featured Roger Ipsen speaking on 'Exploring Native woods of Iowa'. Roger explained how he acquired burls, both native and exotic, and how he carved these burls into unique bowls/objects, several of which were displayed.

At the last meeting we announced an April 15th open house at the Cedar Valley Makers located in the Tech Works building. In addition to the eight CVWA members present (with display projects), there were CVM members, several JD employees, and a group of UNI students enrolled in the class 'The Creative Experience'.
