Discussed the possibility of donating to Salvation Army, Food Bank and Makers.

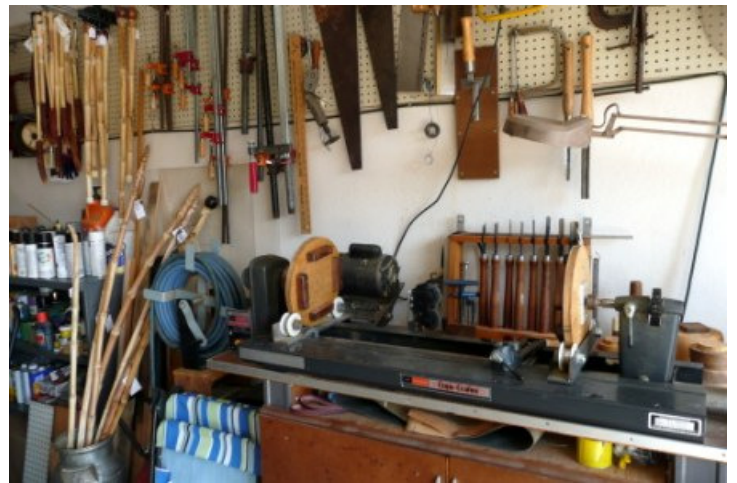
Newsletter due September 27th.
